This person will be part of a team reporting to the Manager of Inspection Services and Sustainability Practices. This position is responsible for technical and skilled work in the regulation and inspection of buildings defined by the *Building Act and Regulations* and in the enforcement of the *BC Building Code*, the *BC Plumbing Code* and Regional District bylaws. The Building Inspector II examines all types of building plans related to new construction, alterations, repairs and additions and inspects or monitors work in progress to ensure that work is performed in accordance with applicable codes and bylaws. The Building Inspector II performs these duties with a minimum of supervision.

The successful applicant must be comfortable with a busy schedule of competing priorities, capable of working independently or as part of a team, self-motivated and results oriented. Applicants must have good observational skills, be able to demonstrate good reporting skills, both verbally and in writing, and must have good communication skills with the ability to deal effectively with the public. Preferred applicants will have BOABC Level One and Plumbing Level One certification, experience as a local government Building or Plumbing Inspector and a valid BC driver's license. Experience as a Journeyman Carpenter or Journeyman Plumber, or related contracting experience would be an asset. Note that an equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered.
