Plumbing & Building Inspector - Regular Full-time

The Building and Plumbing Section of the Community Planning & Development Department is seeking an experienced Plumbing/Building Inspector. The successful candidate will have demonstrated knowledge of the BC Building Code, BC Plumbing Code, and municipal inspection and permitting processes.

This technical, inspectional and regulatory work involves inspecting new and existing structures and building systems, or repair and/or alteration of building types that are classified as complex commercial, industrial, institutional and residential. The inspection ensures compliance with applicable codes, standards, regulations, by-laws, approved plans and specifications and municipal guidelines. The work entails interpretation of applicable by-laws and acts, the issuance of stop work orders as required, inspecting building construction and plumbing installations during progress and on completion, examining plans and permit applications for compliance with standards and regulations, and providing information and assistance to the public on a variety of matters related to the work.

Preferred qualifications include: Grade 12, completion of post-secondary courses in building construction technology, supplemented by completion of the Level 1 certification requirements of the Building Officials' Association of BC and Level 1 certification requirements of the Plumbing Officials' Association of BC, plus a minimum of 2 years experience as a Building/Plumbing Inspector or an equivalent combination of training and experience. A valid Class 5 BC Drivers' Licence is required. If you are an experienced inspector and are excited by this opportunity, you may be the person we are looking for.
