- Deal with contractors and public with regards to plumbing, gas, water, and drainage inspections and issues arising from these inspections.
- Research existing plans and records, and review plans prior to inspection.
- Maintain accurate computer and paper records and files for future reference of all plumbing & gas inspections.

Required Education & Experience:

Completion of Grade 12 or equivalent, supplemented by completion of a recognized apprenticeship in plumbing. Possession of a GB gas certificate and five (5) years of work experience as a journeyman plumber and gas fitter is required. Experience working in a municipal environment is considered an asset.
