Question:

Is the exterior exit door serving a single dwelling unit required to swing on a vertical axis?

Interpretation:

Yes.

Sentence 9.9.6.4.(1) states that the required exit doors shall swing on the vertical axis. An exemption in the same Sentence is provided for the doors in means of egress within dwelling units. The exemption is not referring to the <u>required</u> means of egress and the word <u>within</u> refers to the doors contained <u>within</u> the unit, <u>not the required exterior exit door</u>.
