
Question:

What would be considered acceptable for the installation of a recreational vehicle sewage disposal?

Interpretation:

Detailed installation requirements are not referenced in the 1998 BC Building Code. General statements are made in Section 7.4. for drainage and Sentence 7.6.2.1. (1) for protection of water supply. One method that has been considered acceptable is addressed and illustrated in Interpretation # 4059 published by the Plumbing Officials Association of British Columbia. (See attachment – 2 pages)

Code users under the provisions of Sentence 2.5.1.3. (1) may obtain acceptance by the Local Authority for all such installations.
