Question:

- 1. Are there any requirements for clearances around gas or electric ranges within dwelling units of Part 3 buildings?
- 2. Do the Part 9 clearance requirements for gas and electric ranges cross reference to either Part 3 or Part 6?

Interpretation:

- 1. No, there are no requirements for clearances around gas or electric ranges within dwelling units of Part 3 buildings contained within the B.C. Building Code. Clearances for these types of appliances are contained within the Gas or Electrical Safety Acts and Regulations.
- 2. No, the clearance requirements contained within 9.10.21. and 9.34.1. do not cross reference to either Part 3 or Part 6 of the Code.
