Building Inspector I

Full Time – Term Position - Fort St. John Office

Position Overview

This position, based out of Fort St. John, provides building inspection services to the Village of Pouce Coupe, the District of Taylor, the District of Chetwynd, the District of Hudson's Hope, the District of Tumbler Ridge, and the Peace River Regional District. This four year position is under a participating member municipality agreement, which is agreed upon until 2023.

Reporting to the General Manager of Development Services or designate, the Building Inspector I is responsible for all duties related to building inspection.

Duties include: conducting site inspections; examining building plans, inspecting work to ensure code and regulation compliance; working independently; using sound judgement and making discretionary decisions; processing building permits; responding to inquiries and complaints; and other duties as required.

Qualifications

The ideal candidate will possess a Level 1 Certificate from the Building Officers Association of British Columbia (or be able to acquire a certificate within twelve months), and a high school diploma. They will have at least three years of related experience as a building inspector, with codes, and with the preparation of construction documents and construction inspections.


Additional Information

The hours of work are Monday to Friday, from 8:30 am – 4:30 pm, with one hour for lunch.

The after probation rate of pay for this union position is \$36.21/hr, plus benefits.
