As a member of the team, you will review building and construction plans, issue building permits and perform on-site building inspections.

Under the supervision and direction of the Building Inspection Supervisor, you will ensure that design and materials used during the construction, renovation and alteration of buildings within the Community are compliant with the provisions set out in the BC Building Code, specifically Part 9, BC Plumbing Code, Mission's Zoning Bylaw, other municipal bylaws, policies and procedures.

We are looking for individuals with a keen ability for critical thinking, analytical and problem-solving skills and focus on high quality outputs and results. With a confident and composed demeanor in all work situations, you will have the ability to develop and maintain positive and collaborative working relationships with a broad variety of stakeholders.

You will have completed grade 12 and possess a Diploma in Building Technology from a recognized technical institute or you will have experience at the journeyman level in one of the building trades. You will be a BOABC Member. Candidates with Plumbing Level One (1) Certification is a definite asset. A valid Class 5 BC driver's license and a clean driving record are also required.
