- Canadian Home Builders' Association (CHBA)
- There was discussion about the review of heat loss calculations by building officials. It was suggested that primary responsibility for these calculations appears to be with the contractor. It was noted that this is consistent with discussion on other zones. It was further questioned whether this would be addressed through implementation of the step code as energy advisors or registered professionals would be involved in making these calculations. It was noted that the standard referenced by CHBA is available as part of standards library available to all Association members.
