ABOUT THE ROLE

Reporting to the Manager, Building and Bylaw Services, the newly created position of Manager, Building Inspection Services (Chief Building Official) is responsible for the effective operations of the building department including technical requirements, organizational goals, and community service standards. The Manager oversees permitting, inspection, and plan review-related activities. The Manager is instrumental in the development of the approvals review process, takes a lead role enhancing the use of technology, implements the Energy Step Code, and supports a sustainable approach to construction. The Manager inspires a customer service culture designed to serve the community through collaboration and professionalism.

This is an excellent opportunity for a Chief Building Official with leadership skills in team building, process/technical improvement, quality assurance and problem-solving skills. The preferred candidate will have an Undergraduate Degree or Diploma in Engineering, Building Technology, Architecture, or a related field. In addition, the preferred candidate will have accreditation as a Certified Professional or Registered Building Official with the Building Officials Association of British Columbia (BOABC) Level 2 or Level 3 Qualification, Trades Qualification in carpentry or construction, supplemented by a minimum of five (5) years prior job-related experience in a local government setting. The position requires a minimum of three (3) years of supervisory experience or an equivalent combination of training and experience.
