- Responding to plumbing and piping emergencies throughout the district facilities.
- Develops manual plans, sketches, and drawings for the purpose of job layouts, permit applications, and estimating time and materials required to complete the work.
- Provides technical advice and information to District staff as required.
- Operating a district vehicle and maintaining the vehicle's electrical equipment and materials inventory as necessary.
- Performs other job-related duties of comparable importance, difficulty and responsibility as required.

Required Qualifications
