TERMS OF REFERENCE – AWARDS & RECOGNITION COMMITTEE

1. PURPOSE

1.1. The purpose of the Awards Committee (committee) is to make decisions and provide recommendations relating to Association award programs and volunteer recognition.

2. COMPOSITION AND ORGANIZATION

- 2.1. The committee will be comprised of no less than three, but no more than five members.
 - a. The committee shall be comprised of at least two members of the Executive and at least one member who is not on the Executive.
 - b. The chair of the committee shall be a member of the Executive.
- 2.2. The members of the committee and the chair of the committee shall be appointed and may be removed by the President.
- 2.3. Each committee member continues to serve on the committee until they resign or are removed by the President.
- 2.4. The committee meets at least annually and at the call of the chair.
- 2.5. Three committee members, including the chair, constitute a quorum for committee meetings and decision-making.
- 2.6. All matters considered by the committee will be decided by a majority vote of the members present, including the chair.
- 2.7. The President is an ex-officio, non-voting member of the Committee.
- 2.8. The Executive Director or designate will provide the committee with administrative support.

3. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1.1. The committee is responsible for the following:
 - a. advising and making recommendations to the Executive about Association awards and or recognition programs;
 - b. reviewing applications for Association Student Awards and selecting recipients based on program criteria;
 - c. reviewing nominations for Association Membership Awards and recommending recipients to the Executive based on award criteria; and
 - d. considering any other matters referred to it by the Executive.

2. ACCOUNTABILITY

- 2.1. The committee shall:
 - a. report its discussions to the Executive through the chair; and
 - b. review its terms of reference and operations annually and recommend required revisions to the Executive.
- 2.2. Committee members must sign the Executive Code of Conduct each year.
- 2.3. The committee and its members are subject to the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*.

3. DOCUMENT AMENDMENTS

3.1. The committee will review its terms of reference annually and recommend any required changes to the Executive.
